Principal's Report:

- a. Report cards emailed to students February 15, 2022. Reminder on how parents can access the reports cards will be emailed out to parents.
- b. Change in Learning mode February 22, 2022. Limited changes within school.
- c. School projection for the 2022/23 school year: 253 students. New enrollment of 22 FDK students.
- d. Council received a \$500 parent engagement grant. Council to research potential guest speakers or family engagement nights to utilize the grant
- e. School received money to be used for outdoor education initiatives. School purchased primary and intermediate outdoor equipment kits for student use.
- f. School is still diligent about following covid safety protocols
- g. Hired a third student monitor. School is permitted to have 4, room to hire 1 more.
- h. Six teacher candidates will be joining the school and will work closely with teachers, providing additional support for students
- i. Highschool SHSM art student will be painting a school mural, currently gathering ideas about what should be highlighted in the mural
- j. Portion of school student generated funds has been spent on school maintenance and updating/replacing technology within the school
- k. School has obtained Platinum status with eco stewardship in past years and continues to work hard to achieve Eco goals
- I. School will be installing a concrete slab in the outdoor classroom area to display a bench which was donated to the school in honour of a beloved ERW who passed away.
- m. School is celebrating Black History Month. School purchased new books highlighting great contributions made by Black leaders in Canadian history
